

Entries are now being accepted for the ACMM Rising Star Award. This award was established by great contribution of Prof. Masahiro Yamashita and Prof. Hiroki Oshio. The award will be given to one talented researcher who is 38 years old or younger in the field of Molecular Magnetism or a closely related discipline. The prize is accompanied by a prize of 100,000 JPY, the registration fee for ACMM2020, and an award lecture at ACMM2020 to present his/her work. The jury consists of selected members from the local/international organizing committees of ACMM, and they will select the best applicant.

Eligibility: Researchers who are 38 years old or younger (when applying) with PhD, and have performed their researches or have nationality in Asian countries/regions including Oceanian and surrounding countries/regions

Applications:

- 1) A two-page (maximum) summary of the research
- 2) A list of publications, not including papers under review
- 3) A CV containing contact details for the applicant
- 4) Copies of five publications in PDF format
- 5) Both recommendations and direct applications are accepted.

All materials should be written in English. The electric files of materials 1) - 4) should be sent to <u>acmm2020@chem.kyushu-univ.jp</u> with the subject line "rising star award application". If total capacity of your files is over 5 MB, send divided files or use a file transfer service.
